2022 NCAFP Berry Williams Scholarship

Introduction/Description

The North Carolina Association of Floodplain Managers (NCAFP) is pleased to announce its academic scholarship program for 2022. NCAFP is a non-profit organization established in 1989 consisting of engineers, planners, geographers, land surveyors, zoning officials, emergency management coordinators, community officials, and private sector individuals. NCAFP is dedicated to promoting public awareness of proper floodplain management, promoting professional development, enhancing information exchange, education and outreach, improving floodplain mapping, and reviewing and commenting on pertinent legislation such as the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The scholarship is named in honor of Berry Williams for his years of service as the State of North Carolina NFIP coordinator and assisting with the establishment and growth of NCAFP from the association's beginning in 1989.

Two (2) \$1,250 scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving applicants based on the materials submitted with the application package. This is a one-time award for the selected applicants. Interested college students should review the eligibility requirements and submittals requested below.

Scholarship Type/Amount

- Two (2) scholarships are **\$1,250** each and one-time awards.

Eligibility

- Minimum of GPA 3.0 on 4.0 scale
- Be a **current full-time undergraduate student** in a two- or four-year degree program at a college or university within the State of North Carolina, and within a program related to the disciplines of **floodplain management** (water resources, engineering, planning and zoning, resiliency, coastal management, environmental sciences, hazard mitigation, emergency management, geography/GIS, surveying, etc.)

Additional Information

- Strongly encourage application submissions by students enrolled at Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) or Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs) with a baccalaureate degree program.
- Strongly encourage application submissions by students enrolled at a technical community college with an associate degree program.

Submittal Requirements

- Completed application form
- Official copy of college transcript (to date)
- One letter of recommendation from a college advisor, academic instructor, or supervisor
- 500-word essay (see application form for more details)

Application Process and Deadline

- All application documents must be submitted and received electronically by **January 31, 2022**.
